

Today, there are two local memorial sites that can be visited at any time of the year.

There is a beech hedge maze near Tullibole Castle, at the time the home of the judge who presided over the trials.

At the centre of the maze is a pentagon representing the 5 trials.

There is also a memorial cairn sited at Lamblaires in Crook of Devon, the place of the executions. It lists the names of the accused and you can leave a small stone at it as a memorial of your visit.

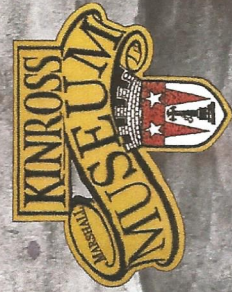
